In accordance with Regulations 24(4) and 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that South Cambridgeshire District Council adopted the Development Control Policies Development Plan Document (DPD) and Northstowe Area Action Plan (AAP) on 19 July 2007. The Development Control Policies DPD and Northstowe AAP form part of the South Cambridgeshire Local Development Framework (LDF) and will replace the existing Local Plan 2004. The LDF comprises a number of DPDs that set out policies and proposals for the development and use of land in the district. The first DPDs cover the period to 2016. The Core Strategy DPD has already been adopted.

Any person aggrieved by the Development Control Policies DPD or Northstowe AAP may make an application under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 to the High Court on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and / or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting on the date on which the DPD was adopted.

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
