


Figure 1 - 1830 mapping with indicative red line boundary.




Figure 3 – 1952 OS mapping with indicative red line boundary.




Figure 6 - Location of agreed.




Figure 7 - Location of assets not agreed to be impacted.




Figure 11 - View from Castle Mound (AVR 01), from within Castle and Victoria Conservation Area, looking towards site across the Central Conservation Area.




Figure 12 - View from Red Meadow Hill (AVR 10) showing the approximate extent of the site and the identified assets. This includes All Saints Church for clarity.




Figure 13 – View from Worts Causeway (**AVR 11**) showing approximate extent of site and the identified assets. Church of Our Lady and St Lukes are identified for clarity.
