

Here is a map from late 2022 of the local Urban Heat Island effect.


It was created using an online tool published on the BBC website; this can be used for any postcode to view the local risk of extreme urban heat.

The dense impact of the existing bulk of the Grafton Centre is obvious.

Equally obvious is the enormous risk of densification and massing of the Beehive site, particularly considering the planned redevelopment of the Grafton Centre site.

The dense housing of North Petersfield risks being squeezed between two enormous summer heat pressure cookers – this must not be permitted to occur.
