#### Reasons for decision

This application was not referred to Planning Committee as the application is for 1-2 self-build dwellings that are near the development framework, which is considered to be a continuation of the development framework. Therefore the material planning considerations, policy and nature and scale of the development were not sufficient to justify referral to planning committee. There is also no planning history on the site that would justify its referral to planning committee.



### 24/042884/OUT - Land West of Whitecroft Road Meldreth

Outline application for the erection of 4 self-build/custom build dwellings and associated development with all matters reserved except access.

# **Key considerations**

The site lies outside the Planning envelope and does not comply with Policy S/7. We understand that the narrow access drive may not qualify for adopted highway status. There are important safety issues with this access.

#### **Decision**

Refer to Planning Committee

### Reasons for decision

The application is to be referred to planning committee as it is for 4 dwellings that are outside of the development framework. This is a scale of development and location that is sufficiently sensitive to justify it being considered by the planning committee. Significant public concern had been raised.

There are also tree that are to be removed that may be considered contrary to policy due to the implication that this would have on the setting and the landscaping of the proposal site. There are no historical implications on the site

### 22/04877/REM - Cambourne West

Application for the approval of reserved Matters (appearance, layout and scale) for Noise Attenuation Bunds following outline planning permission S/2903/14/OL

# **Key Considerations:**

The site has been subject to some political interest and objections received from parish. It has been recommended by managers to bring to delegation meeting to understand if they wish to see this item at committee given the historic political interest.

#### **Decision:**

#### Reasons for decision

It is considered that this application is not to go to Planning Committee. It was indicated by the Case Officer that there has been a high level of interest in the application from the nearest neighbour. Following consultation with the Local Planning Authority and the developer of the site, this has been overcome and the concerns have been reduced, as amendments have been made to the application site. These amendments and alterations to the application have taken away the policy implications, the significance of the application and reduced the complex nature of the proposal. There are no history implications on the site.

## 25/01345/FUL - 1 Royston Road, Foxton

This application is for a mixed development in Foxton next to the railway crossing. It is recommended that this application is brought to Planning committee for determination. This is a mixed use site that has policy implications for the uses that are being proposed. There had been significant public responses. The development will be in a prominent location and due nature of the scale of the proposal it is also to be referred to committee. There are no history implications on the site.
